



## Barbara W. McConnell Social Justice Award

Barbara W. McConnell was a legislator who served in the New Jersey General Assembly. She worked on legislation to combat discrimination against women by lending institutions and to protect women against domestic violence. She served as President of the Board of the Hunterdon County Women's Crisis Service, now known as SAFE in Hunterdon. She also helped obtain the initial state funding for SAFE in Hunterdon. It is in honor of her advocacy work that we have established the Barbara W. McConnell Social Justice Award.

The Barbara W. McConnell Social Justice Award will be given to an individual who has exemplified selfless giving specifically to support survivors and raise awareness of domestic violence.
